

**Request for Proposal for
Vulnerability Assessment and Penetration Testing (VAPT)**

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1. OVERVIEW OF REQUIREMENT

The THE JANATA SAHKARI BANK LTD. has implemented ASP based Core Banking solution & as part of the technological process Bank is planning to conduct "VA & PT Audit" from the qualified and experienced firm/companies on the following terms and conditions.

In this regard, we intend to invite tenders for conducting VA & PT Audit from CERT-In Empaneled vendors only.

2. DEFINITIONS

In this connection, the following terms shall be interpreted as indicated below:

- i "The Bank" means Janata Sahakari Bank Ltd., Satara (JSBL) (including its offices and branches).
- ii "Bid" means the written reply or submission of response to this RFP.
- iii "Vendor/Service Provider" is the successful Bidder found eligible as per eligibility criteria set out as per Bank.
- iv "Services" means all services, scope of work and deliverables to be provided by a Bidder as described in the RFP.

3. INVITATION TO BID

Janata Sahakari Bank Ltd., Satara (hereinafter referred to as "JSBL"), having its Head Office at Satara, is a leading co-operative bank in Satara. JSBL has network of 17 branches including H.O. across the entire Satara District in the state of Maharashtra. This Request for Proposal (RFP) is being issued by the Bank for selection of vendors for conducting of VAPT Audit.

1. In order to meet the service requirements, the Bank proposes to invite Bids from eligible Bidders as per details/scope of work mentioned under the head "Scope of Work" of this RFP.
2. The interested Bidders who agree to all the terms and conditions contained in this RFP may submit their Bids with the information desired in this RFP. Consortium bidding is not permitted under this RFP.
3. Address for submission of Bids and contact details are given under the head "Schedule of Events" of this RFP.
4. The purpose of JSBL behind this RFP is to seek a detailed scope of work and commercial proposal for procurement of the Services desired in this RFP.



5. This RFP document shall not be transferred, reproduced or otherwise used for purpose other than for which it is specifically issued.
6. Interested Bidders are advised to go through the entire RFP before submission of Bids to avoid any chance of elimination. The eligible Bidders are invited to submit the detailed scope of work i.e. Technical and Commercial proposal in a separate sealed envelope in response to this RFP. The criteria and the actual process of evaluation of the responses to this RFP and subsequent selection of the successful Bidder will be entirely at Bank's discretion. This RFP seeks proposal from Bidders who have the necessary experience in VAPT of UCBs, capability and expertise to provide JSBL the proposed Services adhering to Bank's requirements outlined in this RFP.

7. INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDERS

1. BID should contain namely on technical SOW (Scope of Work) & Commercial proposal.
2. Bidder need to provide a separate sealed envelope each for technical SOW and commercial sheet.
3. Technical SOW proposal should be strictly in accordance with the scope mentioned under the head "Scope of Work"..



8. ELIGIBILITY AND TECHNICAL CRITERIA

- i. Bid is open to all CERT-In Empaneled Bidders only who meet the eligibility and technical criteria.
- ii. Vendor should be CERT-In Empaneled.
- iii. In Detail knowledge of RBI Cyber Security Framework.
- iv. Experience of VAPT Audit of the UCBs.
- v. The decision of the Bank in regard to this RFP shall be final and binding on all the Bidders. All disputes or differences in connection with this RFP shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the Courts at Satara only.
- vi. Selected vendor needs to enter into NDA with the Bank.

9. SCOPE OF WORK

Two rounds of Vulnerability Assessment and 1 rounds of Penetration shall be carried out under Vulnerability Assessment and Penetration Testing (VAPT) a year, VAPT should cover the servers, routers, switches, firewalls, Networking systems, Security devices, all public IP's, websites of the Bank at bank's premises.

- Conduct two rounds of VAPT assessments & one rounds of VAPT Penetration a year.
- Submit Audit Compliance certificate for each VAPT
- Head Office & Branch IT Environment
- VAPT of IT Infrastructure (Servers, Firewall, Switch, Router, ATM Machines, Public IPs, Website etc))
- VAPT of API
- Desktop Computers need to include in VAPT

11. DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION OF BIDS

- i. Bids must be received in person only at the Bank's Head Office address of which is given above and by the date and time mentioned in the "Schedule of Events".
- ii. In case the Bank extends the scheduled date of submission of Bid document, the Bids shall be submitted in person only at the above given address as mentioned in the "Basic Details" by the time and date scheduled. All rights and obligations of the Bank and Bidders will remain the same.
- iii. Any Bid received after the deadline for submission of Bids prescribed in the RFP /at the portal, will be rejected.
- iv. No modification in the Bid shall be allowed, after the deadline for submission of Bids.
- v. The Bank reserves the right to accept or reject any Bid in part or in full or to cancel the bidding process and reject all Bids at any time prior to contract.
- vi. The vendor should submit the BID document in two separate sealed envelopes for Technical and Commercial respectively as mentioned above by hand at the address of the Bank given in the "Basic Details" above.



11. Deliverables

The deliverables for VAPT activity are as follows: -

Execution of Vulnerability Assessment and Penetration Testing for the identified network devices, security devices, servers, applications, websites, interfaces and Analysis of the findings and guidance for resolution of the same

- Verification of closure of critical vulnerability.
- Perform compliance verification of closure of findings.
- Draft VAPT Report followed by final report.
- Compliance verification
- Firewall Rules Analysis

The VAPT Report should contain the following: -

- Identification of Auditee (Address & contact information)
- Dates and Locations of VAPT
- Terms of reference.
- Summary of audit findings including identification tests, tools used and results of tests performed (like vulnerability assessment, penetration testing, website assessment, etc.)
- Firewall Rules validations and checking
- Tools used and methodology employed
- Positive security aspects identified
- List of vulnerabilities identified
- Description of vulnerability
- Risk rating or severity of vulnerability
- Category of Risk: Very High(Critical) / High / Medium / Low
- Applicable screenshots.
- Analysis of vulnerabilities and issues of concern
- Recommendations for corrective action



12. SERVICES

- i. Vendor should ensure that the quality of methodologies for delivering the services, adhere to the quality standards/timelines stipulated therefore.
- ii. Vendor's support staff should be well trained to effectively handle queries raised by the employees of the Bank.

13. CONFIDENTIALITY

Confidentiality obligation shall be as per Non-disclosure agreement.

14. EVALUATION

The evaluation of the BID will be done on the basis of criteria mentioned below.

- (1) The main factor of selection will be vendor's technical qualification, experience in VAPT conducted in UCBs, minimum skill set mentioned in "Eligibility Criteria" mentioned above in, and reputation of the vendor and knowledge of RBI Cyber Security Framework.
